

#20. Look at the last three letters of the last word in Yehuda 1,

οις in κλητοις and go back and look at word #8 above, τοις.

τοις is a definite article used here as a personal pronoun "the

(ones)" and it links with κλητοις ("the called" see Romans 1:6),

because both words are dative, masculine, plural (see definite

article chart above, B). Even though κλητοις is an adjective,

it is used like a noun or substantive here, and is called a

pronominal adjective, "the Called (ones)."
