ADON OLAM ("Lord of the Universe") is a common synagogue prayer frequently employed in Jewish services and printed at the beginning of Jewish prayer-books (siddurim) in the daily (morning) prayer section. A little known fact is that the Sephardic and Oriental/Eastern (mizrakhi) versions of the prayer include several extra lines (in bold below in the translation) that are not present in the Ashkenazi version.

The last two extra lines make a reference to the Messiah. It is interesting that they they are not found in modern Messianic Jewish siddurim. However, it is not surprising given the fact that they are all of the Ashkenazi rite. (The translation below I adopted from several others I have read. Text in bold was either translated by Aaron Eby or myself.)

The L-rd of the Universe who reigns Before anything was created. When all was made by his will

His name was called King.

And after all will end

Alone He will reign in majesty.

He was, He is,

And He will be in splendor.

He is one, and there is no other,

To compare or join Him.

Without beginning, without end

And to Him belongs strength and position.

Non-assessable, without likeness,

Without change or equal substitute.

Without connection nor division,

Great in force and power.

And He is my G-d, the living who saves.

My rock in pain during sorrow,

And He is my banner and my refuge.

Who shares my cup in the days I call.
