According to the Encyclopaedia Judaica Vol. 4, p. 243 there is a tradition recorded in Talmudic literature (Sof. 18:7, ed. M. Higger 1937) which alludes to the fact that in Jerusalem during the period of the Bayis Sheni (Second "Temple"), it was customary for the sages to bless a child who had succeeded in completing his first fast day at 12 or 13. When our Moshiach is seen with the sages at the age of 12 in Lk 2:46 the resultant picture of life in pre-Churban Bayis Sheni Judaism inspires us to desire for our youth the spiritual education and preparation involved in a Bar Mitzvah service, especially in the context of a Shabbos Torah Service, some of the components of which are given on these last two pages.
