

“Then the Chag (Festival) of Channukah took place in Yerushalayim. It was winter. And Rebbe Melech HaMoshiach was walking around in the Beis Hamikdash in the area called Ulam Shlomo (Solomon’s Colonnade). Then those of Yehudah encircled Rebbe, Melech HaMoshiach and were saying to him, How much longer are you going to hold our neshamot in suspense? If you are the Rebbe, Melech HaMoshiach, tell us openly.”

Moshiach did tell them openly.

Moshiach said, “For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the Sofrim and Perushim, ye shall in no case enter into the Kingdom of Heaven” (Mt 5:20)

The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, “G-d, I thank thee that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax-collector” (Lk 18:11) (In other words, my religion has brought me merit and deserts...

I deserve the pulpit, I deserve to be seen of men, I deserve the chief seats....

I’m better than other people, and I need to climb the ladder of religious upward mobility... I will therefore put down this one and slander that one and manipulate myself upward and everyone will look at me and I will be oh so religious in my religious spirit.

But the trouble with your Pharisaic religion is one thing: the whole world is guilty and that includes you. (Rm.3:19)

Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin (Rom.3:20).

Moshiach is talking about a righteousness that doesn’t depend on RELIGIOUSITY or on a RELIGIOUS SPIRIT but comes

through SAVING FAITH (Rm.3:21-22)

Salvation comes through the righteousness of faith (Rm 4:13).

And this saving faith is not of your own.

“And the law is not of faith: but The man that doeth them shall live in them. Moshiach hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us (Gal.3:12-13)”

To confess with your mouth Moshiach Adoneinu and believe in your heart Moshiach Tzidkeinu has risen from the dead is to have a blessed life and a Happy Channukah!

Would you like to have your sins forgiven?

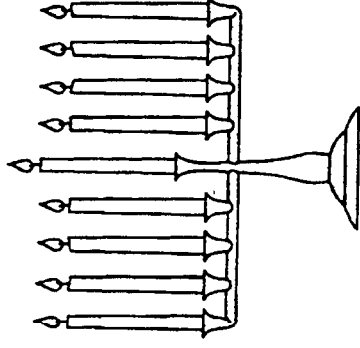
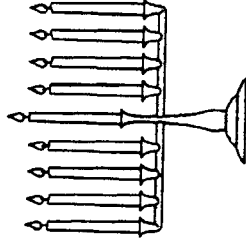
Then you must:
