HIS ASCENSION

Psalm 68: 18.

Thou hast ascended on high. Thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men: yea, for the rebellious also, that the Lord God might dwell among them.

Luke 24: 51—A.D. 33.

While he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

SITTING ON THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD

Psalm 110: 1.

The Lord said unto my Lord, SIT thou at my right hand.

Hebrews 1: 3—A.D. 60.

When he had purged our sins... SAT down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.

EXERCISING THE PRIESTLY OFFICE IN HEAVEN

Zechariah 6: 13—B.C. 519.

He shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Romans 8: 34—A.D. 60.

It is Christ who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

THE CHIEF CORNER STONE

Isaiah 28: 16—B.C. 712.

Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious CORNER STONE, a sure foundation.

1 Peter 2: 5-7—A.D. 60.

Ye are built up a spiritual house... It is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion a chief CORNER STONE, elect, precious... the same is made the head of the corner.

THE CONVERSION OF THE GENTILES TO HIM

Isaiah 11: 10—B.C. 713.

There shall be a root of Jesse, to it shall the Gentiles seek; and his rest shall be glorious.

Isaiah 42: 1—B.C. 712.

Behold my servant, He shall bring forth judgment to the GENTILES.

Acts 10: 45—A.D. 41.

And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the GENTILES also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.

KING IN ZION

Psalm 2: 6.

I have set my KING upon my holy hill of Zion.

John 18: 38, 37—A.D. 33.

Art thou the King of the Jews? Thou sayest that I am a KING. To this end was I born.

SEED OF THE WOMAN

Genesis 3: 15—B.C. 4004.

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her SEED: it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Galatians 4: 4—B.C. 5.

But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law.

1 John 3: 8—A.D. 90.

For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

THROUGH ABRAHAM

Genesis 22: 18—B.C. 1872.

And in thy SEED shall ALL THE NATIONS of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

John 11: 51, 52—A.D. 33.

And this spake he not of himself: but being high priest that same year, he prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation; AND NOT FOR THAT NATION ONLY, but that also he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad.

THROUGH ISAAC

Genesis 21: 12—B.C. 1898.

And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman: in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice: for in Isaac shall thy SEED be called.

Hebrews 11: 17-19—A.D. 54.

By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac; and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy SEED be called: Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead: from whence also he received him in a figure.

THROUGH JACOB AND JUDAH

Genesis 28: 14—B.C. 1760.

In thy Seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

Revelation 5: 5—A.D. 96.

The Lion of the Tribe of Judah, the Root of David.

MESSIAH WOULD COME AT A SET TIME

Genesis 49: 10—B.C. 1689.

The sceptre shall not depart from Judah nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come: and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

Luke 2: 1, 2—B.C. 5.

This taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.

(The sceptre which is the symbol of government was taken away at this time and Judea paid her first taxes to Rome. Then in Bethlehem of Judah, Jesus was born. Luke 2: 7. Shiloh had come.)
