

Prophecy **THROUGH DAVID** Fulfillment

2 Samuel 7: 12, 13—B.C. 1042.
I will set up thy SEED and establish his kingdom forever.
Jeremiah 23: 5—B.C. 599.
I will raise unto DAVID a righteous Branch... who will execute judgment and justice in the earth.

Acts 13: 23—A.D. 45.
Of DAVID'S seed hath God according to His promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus.
Romans 1: 3, 4—A.D. 60.
Of the SEED of David... to be the Son of God.

BORN OF A VIRGIN

Isaiah 7: 14—B.C. 742.
Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Emmanuel.

Matthew 1: 18, 21—B.C. 5.
Mary was espoused to Joseph before they came together she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

BORN IN BETHLEHEM OF JUDEA

Micah 5: 2—B.C. 710.
But thou, BETHLEHEM Ephratah though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel, whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting...

Matthew 2: 1—B.C. 5.
Now, Jesus was born in BETHLEHEM of Judea.

GREAT PERSONS COME TO ADORE HIM

Psalms 72: 10.
The Kings of Tarshish and of the Isles shall bring presents: the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts.

Matthew 2: 2, 11—B.C. 4.
Wise men came from the East to Jerusalem to worship him; they presented unto him gifts: gold and frankincense and myrrh.

COMING INTO THE TEMPLE

Haggai 2: 7, 9—B.C. 520.
I will fill this house with glory. ... The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former: in this place will I give peace.
Malachi 3: 1—B.C. 397.
And the Lord shall suddenly come to His temple.

Luke 2: 27, 32—A.D. 4.
And he came by the Spirit into the temple... For mine eyes have seen thy salvation... A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.
Matthew 21: 12—A.D. 33.
And Jesus went into the temple.

PRECEDED BY JOHN THE BAPTIST

Malachi 3: 1—B.C. 397.
Behold, I will send my messenger; he shall prepare the way.

Luke 1: 17—B.C. 7.
He shall go before him to make ready a people for the Lord.

ANointed WITH THE SPIRIT

Psalms 45: 7.
God hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.
Isaiah 11: 2—B.C. 713.
The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him.
Isaiah 61: 1—B.C. 698.
The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me... to preach good tidings.

Matthew 3: 16—A.D. 27.
The Spirit of God descending upon him.
John 3: 34—A.D. 30.
He whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him.
Acts 10: 38—A.D. 30.
How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power.

Prophecy **A PROPHET LIKE UNTO MOSES** Fulfillment

Deut. 18: 15—B.C. 1451.
The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a PROPHET like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken.

Acts 3: 20-22—A.D. 33.
And he shall send Jesus Christ, for Moses truly said, A PROPHET shall the Lord our God raise up like unto me.

ENTERING ON HIS PUBLIC MINISTRY

Isaiah 61: 1, 2—B.C. 698.
He hath sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives... to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.

Luke 4: 16, 18—A.D. 27.
He hath sent me to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives... to preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

HIS MINISTRY COMMENCING IN GALILEE

Isaiah 9: 1, 2—B.C. 740.
In GALILEE of the nations, The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined.

Matt. 4: 12, 16, 23—A.D. 27.
Jesus departed into GALILEE... The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up... And Jesus went about all GALILEE teaching in their synagogues.

ENTERING PUBLICLY INTO JERUSALEM

Zechariah 9: 9—B.C. 487.
Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion: shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: Behold, thy King cometh unto thee:... having salvation.

Matthew 21: 5—A.D. 33.
Tell ye the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee.

POVERTY

Isaiah 53: 2—B.C. 712.
For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness: and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

Mark 6: 3—A.D. 32.
Is not this the carpenter?... And they were offended at him.
Luke 9: 58—A.D. 32.
Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes... but the Son of man hath no where to lay his head.

MEEKNESS AND WANT OF OSTENTATION

Isaiah 42: 2—B.C. 712.
He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street.

Matt. 12: 15, 16, 19—A.D. 31.
He withdrew himself... and charged them that they should not make him known... He shall not strive, nor cry: neither shall any man hear his voice in the streets.

TENDERNESS AND COMPASSION

Isaiah 40: 11—B.C. 712.
He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.
Isaiah 42: 3—B.C. 712.
A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.

Matthew 12: 15, 20—A.D. 31.
He healed them all... A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.
Hebrews 4: 15—A.D. 64.
For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities.
