

Prophecy**Fulfillment****WORKING MIRACLES**

Isaiah 35: 5, 6—B.C. 713.
Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened and the ears of the deaf shall be untopped. Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing...

Matthew 11: 4-6—A.D. 31.
Jesus answered and said... The blind receive their sight and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached unto them.

WITHOUT GUILE

Isaiah 53: 9—B.C. 712.
Because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

1 Peter 2: 22—A.D. 60.
Who did not sin, neither was guile found in his mouth.

BEARING REPROACH

Psalms 69: 9.
The reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.

Romans 15: 3—A.D. 60.
For even Christ pleased not himself; but as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me.

REJECTED BY HIS BRETHREN

Psalms 69: 8.
I am become a stranger unto my brethren, and an alien unto my mother's children.
Isaiah 63: 3—B.C. 698.
I have trodden the winepress alone.

John 1: 11—A.D. 30.
He came unto his own and his own received him not.
John 7: 3, 5—A.D. 32.
His brethren therefore said unto him, Depart hence... For neither did his brethren believe in him.

HATRED

Psalms 69: 4.
They that HATE me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head.
Isaiah 49: 7—B.C. 712.
Thus saith the Lord the Redeemer of Israel and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth.

John 15: 24, 25—A.D. 33.
If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin; but now have they both seen and hated me and my Father... the word written in their law, They HATED me without a cause.

REJECTED BY THE JEWISH RULERS

Psalms 118: 22.
The stone which the builders refused is become the head of the corner.

Matthew 21: 42—A.D. 33.
Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes.

JEWS AND GENTILES COMBINE AGAINST HIM

Psalms 2: 1, 2.
Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and his anointed.

Acts 4: 27—A.D. 33.
For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel were gathered together.

Prophecy**Fulfillment****BETRAYED BY A FRIEND**

Psalms 41: 9.
Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, who did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me.

John 13: 18-21—A.D. 33.
I speak not of you all; but that the scriptures may be fulfilled. He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me... Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.

HIS DISCIPLES FORSAKE HIM

Zechariah 13: 7—B.C. 487.
Smite the shepherd and the sheep shall be scattered

Matthew 26: 56—A.D. 33.
Then all the disciples forsook him and fled.

SOLD FOR THIRTY PIECES OF SILVER

Zechariah 11: 12—B.C. 487.
If ye think good, give me my price; so they weighed for my price THIRTY pieces of silver.

Matthew 26: 15—A.D. 33.
What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for THIRTY pieces of silver.

HIS PRICE GIVEN FOR THE POTTER'S FIELD

Zechariah 11: 13—B.C. 487.
Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prized at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the POTTER in the house of the Lord.

Matthew 27: 3, 7—A.D. 33.
Judas brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders... and they bought with them the POTTER'S field to bury strangers in.

SMITTEN ON THE CHEEK

Micah 5: 1—B.C. 710.
They shall SMITE the judge of Israel with a rod, upon the cheek.

Matthew 27: 30—A.D. 33.
And took the reed and SMOTE him on the head.

SPIT UPON AND SCOURGED

Isaiah 50: 6—B.C. 712.
I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and SPITTING.

Mark 14: 65—A.D. 33.
And some began to SPIT on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him.
John 19: 1—A.D. 33.
Pilate took Jesus and scourged him.

NAILED

Psalms 22: 16.
They pierced my hands and my feet.

John 19: 18—A.D. 33.
They crucified him.
John 20: 25—A.D. 33.
... in his hands the print of the nails.

FORSAKEN BY GOD

Psalms 22: 1.
My God, my God, why hast thou FORSAKEN me?

Matthew 27: 46—A.D. 33.
Jesus cried, My God, my God, why hast thou FORSAKEN me?
