

**Prophecy****Fulfillment****MOCKED****Psalm 22: 7, 8.**

All they that see me laugh me to scorn, they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, He trusted on the Lord that he would deliver him, let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.

**Matthew 27: 39-44—A.D. 33.**

They that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads. . . Likewise also the chief priests mocking him with the scribes and elders, said, . . . he trusted in God: let him deliver him.

**GALL AND VINEGAR GIVEN HIM TO DRINK****Psalm 69: 21.**

They gave me also GALL for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me VINEGAR to drink.

**Matthew 27: 34—A.D. 33.**

They gave him VINEGAR to drink mingled with GALL.

**INTENSITY OF HIS SUFFERING****Psalm 22: 14, 15.**

I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax: it is melted in the midst of my bowels. My strength is dried up like a potsherd: and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death.

**Luke 22: 42, 44—A.D. 33.**

Father, if thou be willing remove this cup from me. . . And being in an agony, he prayed more earnestly and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

**HIS SUFFERINGS BEING FOR OTHERS****Isaiah 53: 4-6, 12—B.C. 712.**

Surely he hath borne our griefs and carried our sorrows. . . He was wounded for our transgressions. He was bruised for our iniquities. The Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

**Matthew 20: 28—A.D. 33.**

The Son of man came to give his life a ransom for many.

**PATIENCE AND SILENCE UNDER SUFFERING****Isaiah 53: 7—B.C. 710.**

Yet he opened not his mouth. . . As a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

**Matthew 26: 63—A.D. 33.**

Jesus held his peace. **Matthew 27: 12, 14—A.D. 33.** When he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing. . .

**HIS GARMENTS PARTED AND LOTS CAST FOR HIS VESTURE****Psalm 22: 18.**

They part my GARMENTS among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

**Matthew 27: 35—A.D. 33.**

And they crucified him and parted his GARMENTS, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet.

**NUMBERED WITH THE TRANSGRESSORS****Isaiah 53: 12—B.C. 712.**

He was numbered with the TRANSGRESSORS.

**Mark 15: 27, 28—A.D. 33.**

And with him they crucify two thieves. And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, And he was numbered with the TRANSGRESSORS.

**Prophecy****Fulfillment****INTERCESSION FOR HIS MURDERERS****Isaiah 53: 12—B.C. 712.**

And made intercession for the transgressors.

**Luke 23: 34—A.D. 33.**

Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.

**HIS DEATH****Isaiah 53: 12—B.C. 712.**

He hath poured out his soul unto death.

**Matthew 27: 50—A.D. 33.**

Jesus yielded up the ghost.

**NOT A BONE OF HIM BROKEN****Exodus 12: 46—B.C. 1491.**

Neither shall ye break a BONE thereof.

**Psalm 34: 20.**

He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken.

**John 19: 33, 36—A.D. 33.**

When they came to Jesus and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs. For these things were done that the scripture should be fulfilled. . . A BONE of him shall not be broken.

**PIERCED****Zechariah 12: 10—B.C. 487.**

They shall look upon me whom they have PIERCED.

**John 19: 34, 37—A.D. 33.**

One of the soldiers with a spear PIERCED his side. . . And again another scripture saith, They shall look upon him whom they pierced.

**BURIED WITH THE RICH****Isaiah 53: 9—B.C. 712.**

He made his grave with the RICH in his death.

**Matthew 27: 57-60—A.D. 33.**

There came a RICH man named Joseph . . . who went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus . . . and laid it in his own new tomb.

**HIS FLESH NOT SEEING CORRUPTION****Psalm 16:10.**

For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell: neither will thou suffer thine Holy One to see CORRUPTION.

**Acts 2: 31—A.D. 33.**

He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see CORRUPTION.

**HIS RESURRECTION****Psalm 16:10.**

Neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

**Luke 24: 6, 31, 34—A.D. 33.**

He is not here, but is risen. . . And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight. . . The Lord is risen indeed.
