## II Yochanan

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## A letter from Yochanan the Moshiach's Shliach warning about the deceiving spirit of the Anti-Moshiach

## Salutation

From the Zaken (Elder)
To the Gevirah haBechirah (The Chosen Lady) and her Yeladim (Children), whom I love b'Emes (in the Truth), and not only I, but also all those who have da'as haEmes (knowledge of the Truth), because of haEmes (the Truth) that dwells inside us, and will be immanu (with us) l'olam (forever). Chesed Hashem (unmerited kindness and favor), Rachamim Hashem (mercy), and Shalom Hashem (peace) will be immanu (with us) from Elohim HaAv (G-d the Father) and from haMelech haMoshiach Yehoshua, haBen of haAv (the Son of the Father), in Emes (Truth) and Ahavah (Love).

## Emes and Ahavah

I had simcha gedola (much joy) that I have found some of your Yeladim with a walk which is halicha in Derech Emes (conduct in the Way of Truth), just as we received a mitzvah (command) to do so from HaAv. And now I ask you, Gevirah (Lady), not as a mitzvah chadasha (new command) I am writing you, but that which we had from the Beginning, that we should have ahavah (love) one for the other.\* And this is ahavah that we should walk with a halicha according to the mitzvot of Moshiach; this is the mitzvah just as you have heard it from the Beginning-you must walk in it.

Because mat'im rabbim (many misleaders/deceivers) have gone out into the worl the ones not making the Ani Ma'amin (confession that haMelech haMoshiach Yehoshua habah b'basar (has come in bodily flesh); this one is haMat'eh (the Deceiver) and the Anti-Moshiach. Watch out for yourselves, lest you lose what we worked for, but may receive a sachar maleh (full reward). Everyone who runs ahead and does not remain in the Torah of Moshiach does not have Hashem; the one remaining in the Torah [of Moshiach], this one has both HaAv and haBen. If anyone comes to you and does not bring this Torah, do not receive him into your house kehill and do not greet him with "Shalom!" For the on exchanging "Shalom" greetings with him particip in his ma'asim hara'im (evil deeds). I have man things to write to you; I wanted not to do so wit paper and ink, but I have the tikvah (hope) to be with you and to speak peh el peh (in person), th our simcha (joy) may be shleimah (complete). The Yeladim of your Achot haBechirah (Chosei Sister) send you "Shalom" greetings.
