Dear friend or artist for Israel,

We have all heard this: when all else fails,

read the instructions!

When King Josiah rediscovered the Bible around 622 B.C.E., it says in the Hebrew Bible that what was found was a "Sefer Torat Hashem given through Moshe (Moses)." (See. II Chronicles 34:14). It says that Josiah King of Judah tore his royal robes when he heard this holy book read out and when he contemplated all the curses of the divine wrath that would fall on violators of Scripture. Great godly fear then fell upon him, the fear that is the beginning of salvation wisdom, and he immediately

published the word of God abroad by
reading it out loud himself to the assembled
people in the Temple area.

I just finished translating II Chronicles for
the *ORTHODOX JEWISH BIBLE*.

Here's a sample, giving you two points of
comparison, the KJV and the NIV:

King James Version II Chronicles 34:14

“And when they brought out the money that was brought into the house of the LORD, Hilkiah the priest found a book of the law of the LORD given by Moses.”

Same verse, II Chronicles 34:14, *New International Version*

“While they were bringing out the money that had been taken into the temple of the LORD, Hilkiah the priest found the Book of the Law of the LORD that had been given through Moses.”

Same verse, II Chronicles 34:14 *ORTHODOX*

JEWISH BIBLE (BOTH TESTAMENTS):

“And when they brought out the kesef that was brought into the Beis Hashem,

Hilkiyahu HaKohen found a Sefer Torat Hashem given through Moshe.”

Please pray for us. This is a race against time. Will and Ariel Durant tried to write a popular history of the world, but died in

their 80's and 90's in 1981, only getting up to the Napoleonic Era, not even making it to World War I. I have 416 chapters left to finish and the entire Bible, both Testaments, will be completed. Then I have to edit the entire NT in both Yiddish and Hebrew. Will I too run out of time?

God is helping. When the impossible is done, you know God is doing it! Everyday a breakthrough is given. This is why we have two prayer meetings a week. Like the race

to determine the entire human genetic code, in somewhat the same way we are mapping out all the Greek words in Matthew through Revelation in Hebrew and Yiddish. The goal is to reach all the Orthodox Jews in the world through publishing this Hebrew/Yiddish NT version free-of-charge on the Internet. But unlike the race called the Human Genome Project, which has as its goal the predicting of disease susceptibility and other health concerns, we are praying for every Jewish

person in the world that he or she might have a genuine II Chronicles chapter 34 "Josiah" salvation experience with the holy words of God. Whereas the publicly financed Human Genome Project and the other effort, Celera, spend 100's of millions of dollars, I figured we have only about 11 and a half cents to pay for each Yiddish and Hebrew word for the Hebrew/Yiddish NT we are processing and translating. Romans chapter 8, for example, cost us about \$100. It contains 839 words in Yiddish. You can

check my math; math is not my strongest ability. I had only twice that amount in my pocket (i.e. 23¢) when this project really took off, Labor Day, 1978. Yet God is strong and rich whenever we are poor and weak. And I am confident that God will complete the good work He began in us (Philippians 1:6), and that many Jewish people, including Orthodox Jewish people, will have a "Josiah" II Chronicles 34 experience with the Word of God. What we are talking about is the Bread of Life, the Word of God. When we get on

our faces and pray every Monday and every Wednesday night, we ask God for miracles in our ability to distribute Manna from Heaven, even Manna from Heaven to the whole world.

Let me give you an example of the kind of thing that God can do, but I'll use the illustration of food, since Scripture is also food, spiritual food. The largest supermarket chain in Britain wanted to serve Internet customers. They did not want to

waste a lot of money and fail. They wanted to succeed. So instead of building expensive centralized warehouses, they decided to get double duty out of their 690 local stores scattered all over Britain. This would shorten delivery time in each local area to no more than 25 minutes. However, to do this, they had to figure out a way to keep from clogging their store aisles and frustrating store customers while workers serving Internet customers picked and packed groceries for home delivery to

Internet customers ordering online. The computer helped because the computerized carts they used helped them efficiently pick and pack several orders simultaneously as the products were automatically scanned into a virtual cash register and then put on delivery trucks to be ferried to the Internet customer who only 25 short minutes before had typed his or her order into a home computer. Now let's look at Romans chapter 1, verse 1 in Yiddish

With the help of God we now have a computer program that we can use to find what each of these words in Hebrew means in English, all with the click of a button. This week I was able for the first time to fully edit *Romans 1:1-5* in Hebrew and Yiddish. I rejoiced until I realized how long it took me and how long it might take to finish the entire project.

But what blessed my heart and gave me hope was what God did with two men named Anthony. The first God-sent Anthony gave me a key to a free room and checked me into the "Wishing Well" motel in 1978. This was seven and a half years after I had had my own "Josiah" II Chronicles 34 salvation experience in Hollywood, California, reading the just published *New English Bible* in the Read More Bookstore on Hollywood Blvd in Hollywood, California. But

on Labor Day, 1978, in a free motel room in Boynton Beach Florida, I prayed and asked God to give me a film viewable all over the world called *The Rabbi From Tarsus*. Then, this month, on July 4, 2001, almost 23 years later, another God-sent Anthony was dispatched by God and he compressed *The Rabbi From Tarsus* video with Hebrew subtitles into a Microsoft Media Player file and uploaded it onto our website [www.afii.org/video.htm] so that the film is literally viewable all over the world, and any

computer in the world can view it free of charge on the Internet. So from God-sent Anthony to God-sent Anthony, God did it, and my only contribution was 23 cents, all the money or resources I had to my name on Labor Day weekend, 1978. Praise God! Praise God! Praise God! Give God the Glory for what He has done! And the Same God that did all that, will finish the Hebrew and Yiddish versions and the Orthodox Jewish Bible (Both Testaments) and will put them all up on the Internet to be distributed

everywhere free of charge. What is impossible with man is possible with God. Hallelujah! Hallelujah! Hallelujah!

The second God-sent Anthony who checked *The Rabbi From Tarsus* into the afii.org website, also redesigned much of the website free of charge. Then he sent us the video with Hebrew subtitles digitalized on DVD and also VCD Video Compact Disc so that, with Hebrew Subtitles, we can duplicate it and give it to

many many Israelis and others!

I cried out to Yeshua that night in 1978 and

Yeshua was there then and here now,

answering prayer "exceeding abundantly

more than we can ask or think." On the last

page here you have a Xerox of what I carry

around with me every day in my pocket

Bible, so that if anyone in the Homeless

shelter evangelistic crusades or in the

weekly street preaching open air meetings

questions the veracity of what I am

solemnly testifying, then I have a cup of the

“manna,” like the Jewish people saved in the Ark of the Covenant., as it says in *Exodus 16:33*, “And Moses said unto Aaron, “Take a pot, and put an omer full of manna therein, and lay it up before the Lord, to be kept for your generations.”

And I know that God will bless those who bless the Jews, because, even though following Yeshua will cost you everything, in faithfulness to Him and to His commands, there is great reward. Whoever tries to

keep his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for Him, will find it. When I came downstairs on July 4, 1971, and excitedly told a minister friend in Chicago God was calling me to become an ordained minister, I thought on that never-to-be-forgotten day that I would have to sacrifice for the Lord the professional acting I had been doing (and I was willing to give it up), but on the exact same day, exactly 30 years later, on July 4, 2001, the Lord put *The Rabbi From Tarsus* on the Internet for the whole world

to see! Praise His Holy Name forever!
